ORDER NO. 2020-07

ORDER EXTENDING SUSPENSION OF PARTS OF DISTRICT RULES & REGULATIONS FOR DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES WITHIN DISTRICT JURISDICTION

WHEREAS in REGULAR session of the DeWitt County Drainage District No. 1 on **June 17, 2019**, the District enacted Order No. 2019-02 "Adopting Master Drainage Plan, Rules & Regulations and Drainage Criteria Manual" as authorized by Texas Water Code §49.211, with said Plan, Regulations and Criteria Manual having been updated periodically since that time; and

WHEREAS in SPECIAL session of the DeWitt County Drainage District No. 1 on May 7, 2020, the District found it appropriate to suspend some Regulations, for the following reasons:

- The District has been unable to secure interlocal agreements with the City of Cuero and the County of DeWitt, and this lack of intergovernmental cooperation has caused confusion to numerous developers; and
- The current COVID-19 pandemic has greatly depleted District personnel resources, and the District finds at this time that it cannot in a timely manner carry out the following: process development regulations, answer questions from prospective developers or participate in lengthy pre-development meetings, work on items which would clarify and simplify the process for the general public, check building sites for conformity with District regulations, send out legal notices when necessary, and keep the District website continually updated with the latest developer information; and

WHEREAS in REGULAR session of the DeWitt County Drainage District No. 1 on **September 4**, **2020**, the District finds it necessary to extend the suspension of Order No. 2020-07 for the same reasons as stated above;

NOW THEREFORE, in the interest of public health and welfare, this <u>limited-duration</u> amendment to the District's Rules & Regulations is to be extended to the remainder of calendar year 2020 and will expire at midnight on December 31, 2020.

THIS ORDER IS ENACTED AND APPROVED AT A PUBLIC MEETING OF THE DEWITT COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO. 1, HELD IN COMPLIANCE WITH CHAPTER 551 OF TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE (TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS ACT), ON THIS THE 4TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER 2020.
